02. ONE MONTE-CARLO



The One Monte-Carlo complex is a major new development in the very heart of Monaco, offering a global luxury experience just yards from the iconic Place du Casino.

Combining high-end residential units, retail spaces, top restaurants, cultural and business facilities, the ultra-modern district surrounds the Promenade Princesse Charlene, a new pedestrian area lined with trees and seven buildings, designed to be a transparent and green space.
